Emergency Response & Fire Drills

Regular fire drills and emergency response drills will be held throughout the year to practice student safety procedures. Our first full school Fire Drill is scheduled for September 29th. Classroom teachers will walk through expectations and practice with students during the first week of school.



School Supplies

For the 2023-24 school year Arden will be providing basic school supplies to students in Kindergarten to grade 5. Instead of parents purchasing individual sets of supplies, families provide money to the school and the school will purchase supplies for each student. This approach will ensure equity and equality among all students and will save parents time (no shopping!) and money (ordering in bulk, our discount on school supplies is significant). The only items parents will have to provide are a backpack, a lunch bag, and appropriate shoes for gym.

For Kindergarten to grade 5, the fee will be \$15.

The office will accept e-transfer, cash, or cheque.

School Bus

In continued partnership with our transportation provider, First Student, Comox Valley Schools, SD71, is offering First View/Parent View, a bus tracking and parent communications app for your smartphone or desktop.

- To create an account, you will need your student's pupil ID, along with a special code:
- The code will be provided from the district once your student is a confirmed registered regular rider with the bus company.
- The district will be sending out codes once received from the bus company.

Rules for Riding the Bus

- Be at the bus stop 5 minutes ahead of the posted schedule. The bus will not wait for those who are late
- Stay on the shoulder or sidewalk, well away from the pavement, while waiting for the bus
- Do not run beside the bus while it is moving
- Boarding the bus will be in single file
- No saving spots in line or seats on the bus
- Take your seat right away



- The bus driver is always in charge
- Remain seated while the bus is in motion
- No eating on the school bus
- No fighting, bullying or horseplay on the bus
- Do not throw litter out the window of the bus
- Always keep head and arms in the bus

Class Placements

The most frequent question we receive is, "Who is my teacher this year?". We are still sorting through new registrations and figuring out who has moved. As a result, we are still making tweaks. The first day of school will have previous students returning to their classes from last year while all new students will join Ms. Bell in the library. On the evening of September 6^{th,} you will get an email from us with your child's class placement information.
