School Forms

You may notice that students were not sent home with a large package of start-up forms.

Our school has embarked on a project to make forms electronic. It is our goal to reduce paper consumption, reduce the risk of losing forms containing sensitive information, reduce the duplication of information, make some administrative tasks less paper intensive, and help make processes for families more seamless.

Clevr contains several important forms that we ask families to complete:

- **Student Verification Form** update contact information, as well as any medical or legal alerts the school needs to be aware of.
- SD71 Protocol and Consent Forms review District policies and indicate your preferences.
- Walking Field Trip Form provide permission for your child to participate in local walking field trips.

Thank you for taking the time to review, update, and submit these forms. Keeping this information current helps us ensure a safe, supportive, and well-prepared learning environment for your child.

Accounts have been created for families already registered in our school. When you arrive at the Clevr website, just select, "Forgot password" to begin the process.

Open Gym

We are excited to share that Open Gym will be available for students on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings. Doors will open at 8:15 a.m., giving students a chance to come in early, get active, and start their day with movement and fun.

Students should enter through the outside gym doors, where staff will be ready to welcome them. This is a great opportunity for students to connect with friends, try different activities, and enjoy some extra playtime before classes begin.

Breakfast Program

We know mornings can be busy! Our breakfast program is here to help, starting at **8:15 a.m.** each day. The **outside door of the multipurpose room** will be open, and any student who didn't get a chance to eat or is still feeling hungry is welcome to come in for something to eat before the day begins.

School Supplies

For the 2025-2026 school year Aspen Park Elementary will be providing basic school supplies to students in Kindergarten to grade 7. Instead of parents purchasing individual sets of supplies, families provide money to the school and the school will purchase supplies for each student. This approach will ensure equity and equality among all students and will save parents time (no shopping!) and money (ordering in bulk, our discount on school supplies is significant). The only items parents will have to provide are a backpack, a lunch bag, and appropriate shoes for gym.


Grade 1 to grade 7 the fee will be \$40 Kindergarten fee will be \$30
