Please read the information below regarding programs available for the 2026/2027 school year.



Registration for Kindergarten and other programs for 2026/27 School Year Important information for Comox Valley Schools (SD 71) Families

Comox Valley Schools (School District No. 71) will be enrolling Kindergarten students (Neighbourhood, French Immersion, Montessori, Indigenous, Pathways Learning Community, ENTER, Fine Arts and eClasses) in District schools for attendance in September 2026. To be eligible for enrolment in September 2026, a student must turn five (5) years of age by December 31, 2026. Each child's birth certificate and proof of address must be uploaded for registration. BC Services Cards will not be accepted as proof of birth however your child's <u>BC Personal Health Number (PHN)</u> is required on the registration form. A Passport or Landed Immigrant authorization are suitable forms of documentation in lieu of birth certificates.

Early French Immersion (Ecole Puntledge and Robb Road), Montessori (Queneesh and Courtenay) and Indigenous K-1 (Ecole Puntledge and Aspen Park):

- Online Expression of Interest is open Tuesday, January 13 until Friday, January 16 at 6:00 pm. (The expression of interest will remain open after the initial intake for waitlist applicants). Program entry is based on a lottery system, not first come first serve. Please complete the expression of interest form for your program of choice on the SD71 registration page www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/student-registration.
- . The indicated school you select will contact you and provide directions about confirmation or wait listing for placement.
- Indigenous K/1 at Aspen Park (registering K/1) and Ecole Puntledge (registering K-only): Priority will be given to students of ancestry before Friday, January 16, 2026.
- · Siblings of current students in the programs above will have priority, if they are registered before Friday, January 16, 2026.

Pathways Learning Community (K-5 Airport) and ENTER (K-7 Aspen):

- Online Expression of Interest for all grades opens Tuesday, January 13 until Friday, January 16 at 6:00 pm. (The expression of interest will remain open after the initial intake for waitlist applicants). Program entry is based on a lottery system, not first come, first serve.
- Siblings of current students in the programs above will have priority, if they are registered before Friday, January 16, 2026.
- . The indicated school you select will contact you and provide directions about confirmation or wait listing for placement.

Please note that online expression of interest from Indigenous K/1 and ENTER (K-7) is January 13 to January 16.

Neighbourhood School:

Parents are asked to register their children at their current neighbourhood catchment school using the online registration located on our website www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/student-registration starting Tuesday, January 20, 2026. While most, if not all, students living in a school's local catchment will be accommodated at that school, they cannot be guaranteed placement in the catchment area school and may be required to go to the nearest school having space available. To determine your neighbourhood catchment school, please visit our district website at comoxvalleyschools.ca, click on "Schools" and go to "Schools Locator". If you live in an area where busing is provided, please complete a Bus Transportation Registration Form which is located at https://www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/student-transportation. All students travelling on School District No. 71 school buses must carry a bus pass. If you do not have access to technology to complete the online registration, connect with your neighbourhood school for registration support.

Neighborhood Kindergarten Registrations opens January 20th.

Hot Lunch

Hot Lunch will be open for January, February and March ordering on November 27 until December 7th.

- 1. Go to http://aspenpark.hotlunches.net
- 2. Click on "Click Here to Register"
- 3. Our school access code is APHL
- 4. Enter your name, email address and phone number. Choose a User ID that you will use for access to our on-line hot lunch program. Enter a password and then enter it again to verify that it is correct.
- 5. Once you are registered, you will be logged into the website.
- 6. Please add your child(ren) by clicking on the "STUDENTS" button. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU SELECT THE CORRECT TEACHER/ DIVISION FOR YOUR CHILD(REN**). Once your children have been added to the system you will be able to place lunch orders immediately by clicking the "Order" button beside each child's name.

 - Please note that if you are paying by cash or cheque you MUST print off a
 Remittance Form and attach it with your payment. This form is located under the

 school office.
