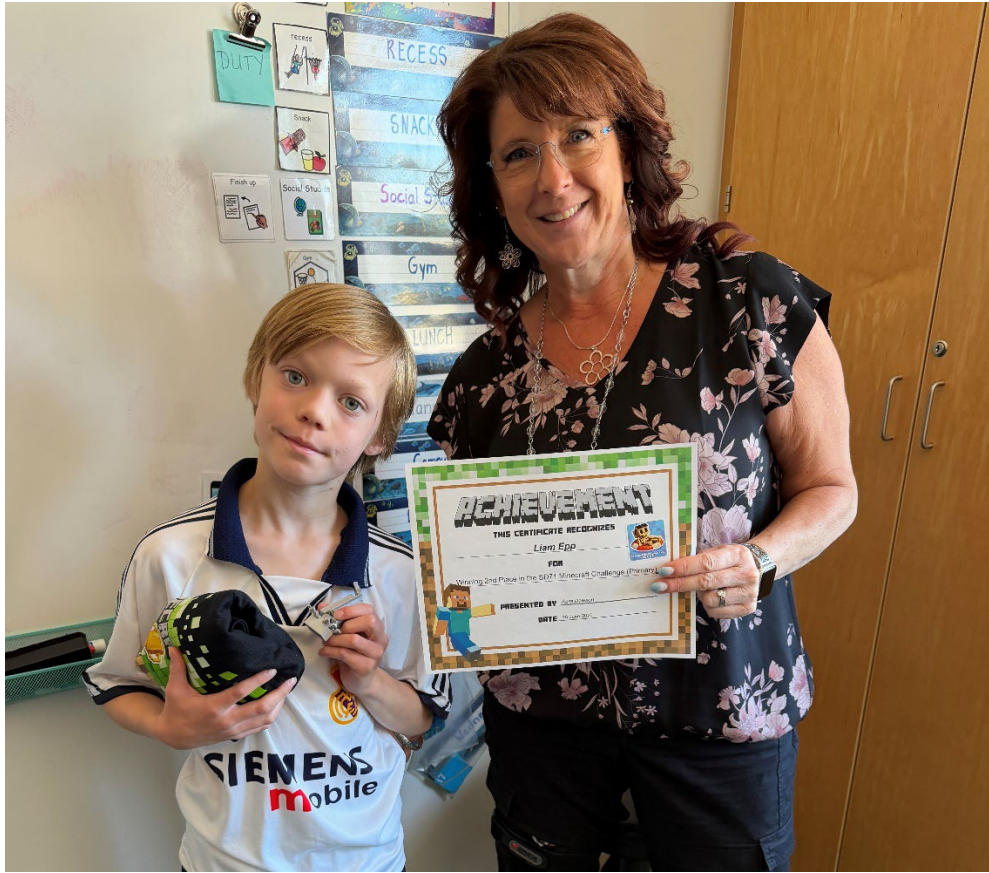
- Kindergarten to Grade 7 the fee will be \$40
