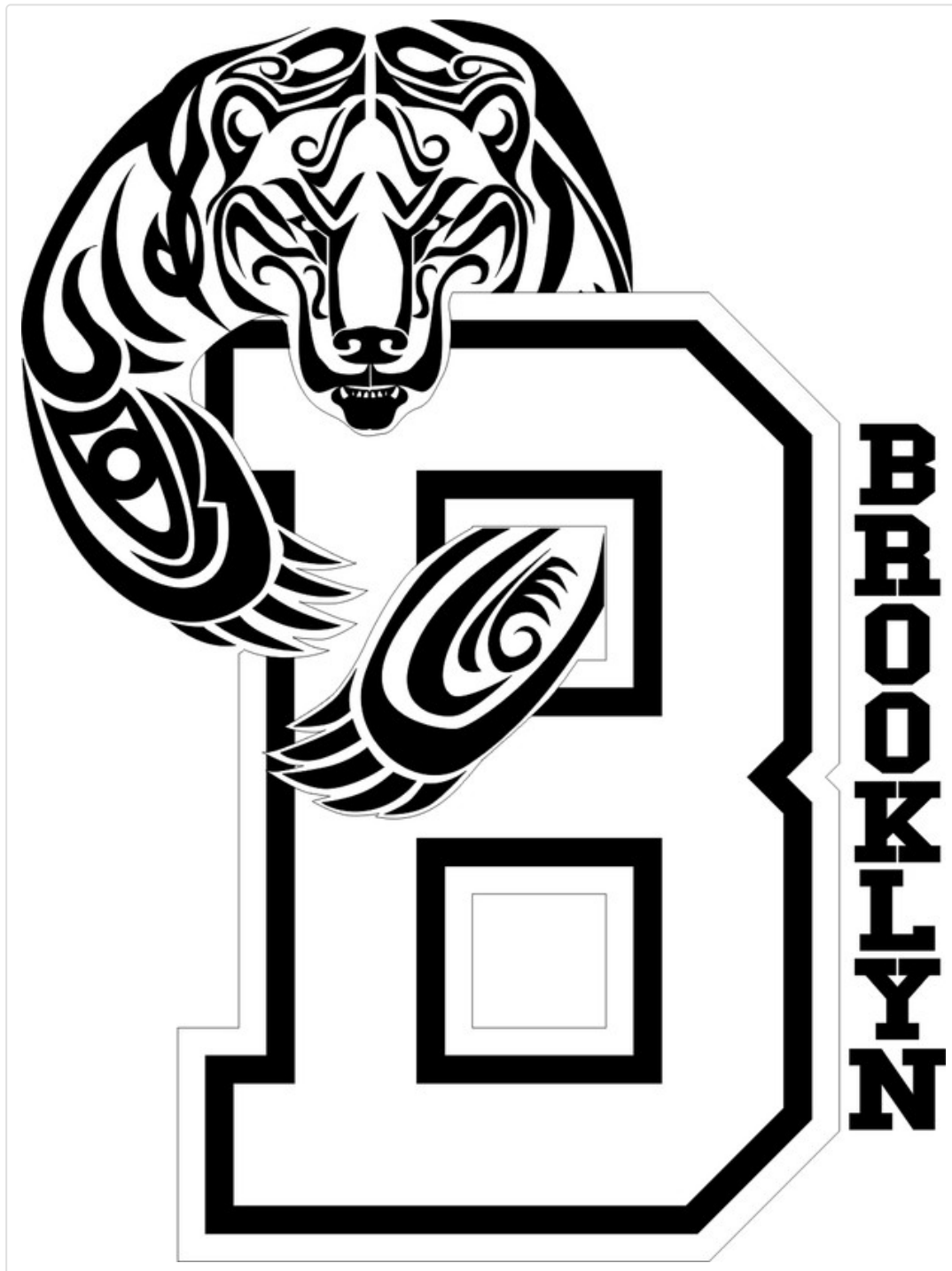

October 19th - Au Coeur de L'ile (grade 4-7 only)

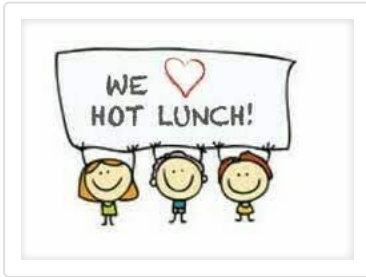

Last Day for Hot Lunch Ordering is Wednesday September 28th - No Late Orders Accepted

Its that time again! The first hot lunch of the year will be Thursday October 6th,2022. Again we will be ordering month by month. **For October ordering the site will open Wednesday September 21st and will close Wednesday September 28th.** Since we need to get numbers to the vendors there will be **NO LATE ORDERS.** Due to food cost increase all the vendors have had to increase their prices slightly which is reflected in our slight increases.

If your child is away on hot lunch day please call the office before 11:00am if you would like us to either save it or give it to a sibling in another class. If we don't hear by 11am the lunch will be donated to another student at the school. Please **DO NOT** email the PAC website since it may not be checked that morning and this way we don't miss any requests. **PLEASE call the office.** Lunches can be picked up between 11:30-12 or after school, please just specify when you call in.

Every year you must set up a new account, here is a quick reminder how to set it up.

1. First go to the hot lunch website. **Brooklyn.hotlunches.net**
2. Register-create an account
3. Access code is **BLHL**
4. Pick which child your ordering for. Choose their classroom so that their lunch gets delivered to the proper classroom.
5. Indicate if you would like to volunteer that week. There is a box under each week that you can click. Depending on the week there will be 3 or 4 slots available. Volunteers will need to arrive at 11:00 and will be done around 12:00pm.
6. Review your order and pick either Bambara (which has replaced pay pal) or E-transfer. **Please send e-transfers to brooklynhotlunch@gmail.com** Make sure to enter your child's name in the notes. **We will NOT ACCEPT CHEQUE OR CASH.** **If you have any hot lunch questions you can either email kristinlewall@gmail.com.
