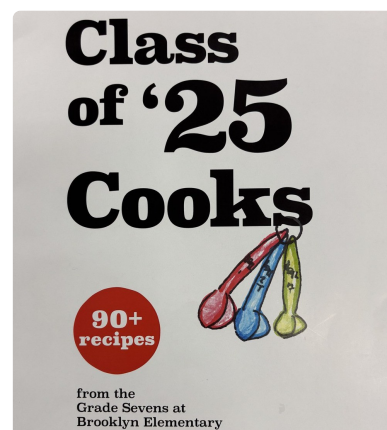


## Grade 7 Cookbook!
