Students arriving late or leaving early must check in/out at the office prior to going to class/leaving school.

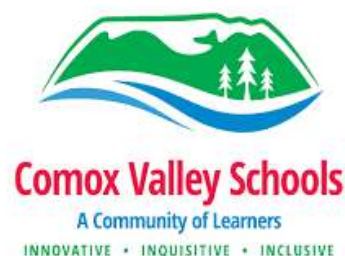
