Guiding Stars - this weeks numeracy and literacy prompts



Literacy: Pick your favourite book of the day, try to read it without looking at the words, pictures only (inference). Once done, start again and read all the words on each page. Did you remember most of the words or the plot of the book?

Numeracy: Count how many plates, bowls, knives, spoons and forks are on the table - what is the sum? The next night, count all the plates, bowls, knives, spoons and forks in the cupboard - what is the sum?
