

Careers Curriculum: Picture Book Exploration

Book Title: maybe by Kobi Yamada

Materials Needed: Picture book, whiteboard and pens, Acrostic Poem Sheet, Steppingstones sheet	
<b>Question</b> : What do you like? What can that turn into? What does a journey look like?	Grade: 1,2,3
<b>Big Idea</b> : Confidence develops through the process of self-discovery.	First Peoples Principles: Learning is holistic, reflective, reflexive, experiential, and relational.

#### **Lesson Ideas:**

### Step 1:

• Do a read aloud with your class

### Step 2:

Have the class write an Acrostic Poem. Use your whiteboard to explain

Prompt: MAYBE – Someday I will...

• After writing their acrostic poem have students think about what the steps might be to accomplishing some of their "I will's". They can do this with their big buddy OR with a partner.

#### **Extension:**

• Once students have some ideas about something they want to do, have them use the steppingstones sheet and use words or symbols to plot out



- the steps needed to get there. They can do this with a big buddy, at school with a partner or with their parents.
- Next, have students find 2 people around the school and interview them (students or District staff) and have the students record those journey's and how they accomplished them- something they wanted or wanted to do.
- Email parents or community members to see if someone will come in to speak to your class about their journey to where they are now.
