

Careers Curriculum: Picture Book Exploration

Book Title: When I Grow Up By Al Yankovic

Materials Needed: Picture book, whiteboard and sheet	l pens, paper, Comic strip
Question: How can I as a passionate learner, learn more about the kinds of jobs available to me for when I am old enough to work?	Grade : 2, 3, 4
Big Idea : Communities include many different roles and require many different skills.	First Peoples Principles: Learning is holistic, reflective, reflexive, experiential, and relational.
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Lesson Ideas:

Step 1:

Read allowed, read the picture book to your whole class.

Step 2:

Think- Pair-share

On a piece of paper, have your students consider what jobs they like and what jobs they may have in the future- they can dream up what's to come. As we know, many of our students will have jobs that currently do not exist.

Then share with a partner and then ask for 2-3 ideas that the students came up with in their pairs. Write these on the board, some may be more hobbies, but this is okay too.

Step 3:

- Students will now get a piece of the comic strip. They will take some time to draw out, and write a bit of text, about "A day in the life of ___ You may want to do this using the app *Toontastic* (comic strip).
- Students will draw out what they will be doing in one of their future jobs with a little commentary.



• 2 boxes can be fun, and one should show what it really looks like.

Extension:

- Poplet: Web of ideas. After Step 2, students could consider what skills or abilities they would need for the job they are interested in having in the future.
- They could then explore the question: What does a _____ do?
- If you had them choose 2 careers of interest, they could do a Venn Diagram- comparing 2 different jobs.
