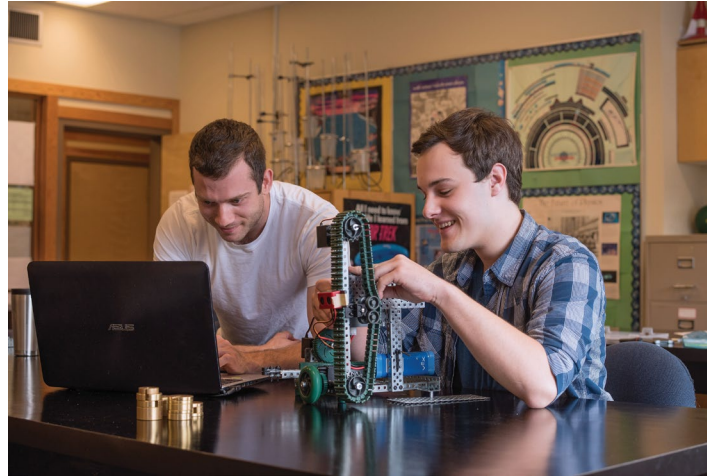

What is Dual Credit?

Dual Credit means taking a college course while still in high school and receiving college course credits and high school elective course credits at the same time.

This opportunity is for Grade 11 and 12 students, who meet the pre-requisites.

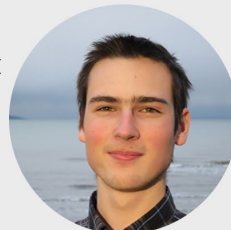

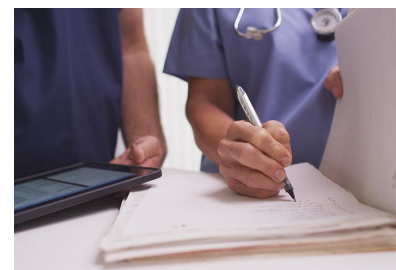

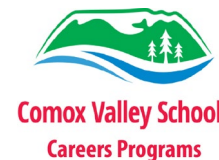
