Dear parents and caregivers,

Did you know that we are required to do 6 fire drills per school year? I'm very proud of our students and staff, and also our Blackberry Lane neighbours. At the beginning of the year, we fielded many questions when we talked about potential emergencies at school ("what if this... and what if that..." – all great questions and concerns!) There was also some fear around the drill (and the eventuality of a burning building.)

During a drill, we debrief at the bleachers. We can always be a bit quieter, to ensure we can hear important directions during



a real fire, but generally, everyone works together to get out of the building safely and efficiently.

This week, div. 2 went to the firehall to tour the station, but also to review the plans they made for their own houses, siting evacuation routes and a meeting (muster) point. The firehall has been actively involved in ensuring our safety. They participated in a fall drill, and they are keen to share their knowledge at the hall (or here at school). <u>G</u>ilakas'la!


