ESTIMATION STATION - CONTEST!

How many pretzels – broken and whole – do you estimate are in the jar? The closest estimate (without going over) wins a jar of pretzels for their classmates to share! Contest closes Friday at noon.

Students practice their estimation skills every day – in math and real life. Estimation is such an important skill for so many applications:

- 1. **Helps us check for reasonableness.** When doing a math problem, does the answer make sense?
- 2. **Supports mental math.** When students hone their estimation skills, they also get more comfortable with rounding, approximating, and manipulating numbers in their heads.
- 3. **Promotes critical thinking.** Estimation encourages students to think about the size, scale, or reasonableness of a number instead of relying solely on exact calculations.
- 4. **Saves time**: In real-world situations—like shopping, budgeting, or cooking—exact numbers aren't always necessary. Estimating helps make quick, informed decisions.
- 5. **Is useful in real life:** From measuring materials for a project or sharing food, estimation comes in handy all the time. It's a life skill that helps with problem-solving in day-to-day scenarios.
