# FILLONGLEY BEACH DAY - JUNE 19TH @ 10:30-2:00 PM

We are excited to celebrate National Indigenous Peoples Day at Fillongley Provincial Park on Thursday, June 19<sup>th</sup>.

This 23-hectare park has special significance – as is evidenced by the middens.

Archaeological digs (since 1956) have noted 33 sites on Denman Island (as a whole) and identified at least five likely village locations that are approximately 2500-3000 years old. At Fillongley, archaeologists unearthed the remains of dwellings such as house pillars and oblong depressions and other evidence to be the remnants of plank houses.

• Small, portable snack like an apple or granola bar (if you get hungry between 11-noon).


