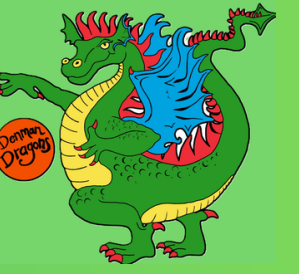

Because when cars are parked in front of the school they block the school bus.

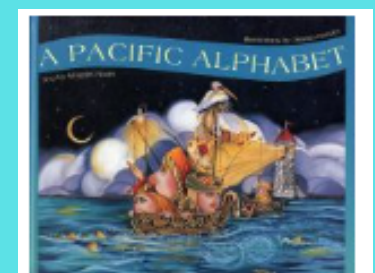
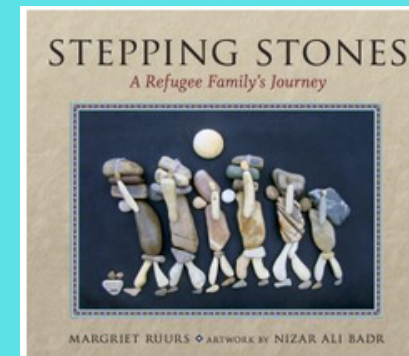


DICES News

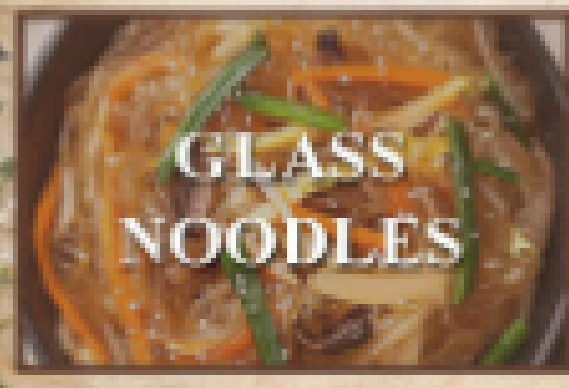

The erase | Report It tool lets you send a secure, anonymous and confidential message to your school or school district's safe school coordinator, who will follow up on it right away. You do not have to provide your name unless you want to. Messages are only monitored during your school's operational hours. Crisis Notification Network

Parents can be informed of emergency situations via the School's Crisis Notification Network (phone or electronic notifications).

Parents can opt in to receive text-based notifications for certain emergency events.
