First 2 pages of insurance is required, showing minimum of \$1 million liability Copy of Driver's License.

All information should be sent by email to <u>puntledge@sd71.bc.ca</u>. Scanning documents or taking a picture will work to send via email.

The School District's updated volunteer policies require **volunteers** with Puntledge Elementary to complete a criminal record check.

There is no charge to volunteers the checks are valid for 5 years and the results are usually confirmed in 2-4 weeks. Please keep your proof of submission until results are confirmed.
