- Bike program for all grade 4s and 5s Sept 23-26.

## **Unfinished Business:**

- 1. New Treasurer needed. Caleigh Barth has expressed interest and met with Garth Yule (outgoing treasurer) to help draft the budget for this year. No other interested members. Motion: to elect Caleigh Barth to the position of PAC Treasurer. The motion carried with all in favour by show of hands.
- DPAC rep needed. Tom Cutler is currently holding this position but he is working out
  of town so he can't continue. Discussed the role. Some parents are interested but will
  think about it. Please contact the Puntledge PAC email if you are interested in this
  role.
- 3. Social Media Coordinator needed. Emily Brown would like access to post about volunteering opportunities. It is currently difficult to access the group as it was made by a parent who is no longer at the school and the password has been lost. Action item: New Facebook group will be made and Emily Brown will reach out to the volunteer that was interested.
- 4. Salmon Day Updates: Renee van Doorninck provided updates on organizations who have agreed to participate so far. No donations of smoked salmon have been confirmed for this year so might go without and just have hot chocolate. **Action item:**Emily Brown to send out an email to request volunteers.
- 5. Fundraising:
  - a. Mabel's Labels Fundraiser update: End of last year made \$76. We have made about \$100 so far on label sales this month. We can leave this open indefinitely and send reminders seasonally (eg. hoodie sales etc).
  - b. Is there an update on the school's request for an additional outdoor basketball court? No, still waiting for a quote.
  - c. All other fundraising ideas: please send your ideas or interest in running a fundraiser for the PAC to the puntledge PAC email.

# **Reports of Officers**

Treasurer: Caleigh Barth.

- Gaming grant covers field trips and no longer covers bursaries.
- Hot lunch is our biggest fundraiser. We need a hot lunch coordinator. Action item:
   Emily Brown to reach out to members who have expressed interest in helping with hot lunch in the past.
- Book fair. Pamela Poweell no longer has a child at the school so we will need another coordinator if we do this fundraiser. This makes a fair amount of money. Can be overstimulating for the kids and can be disappointing for some kids. Will discuss next month. Action item: Add to October PAC agenda.
- End of school fun day: was a great event but expensive. Could cut down on the concession costs.
- Budget is at a deficit. Could remove the bursary and EDAS. Could charge for the
  concession on the fun day and just pay for the bouncy castle. Reduced the amount
  given to classrooms by ½ can do this because of the affordability grant. Budget
  deficit is now \$1400 which is better.
- Return it fundraiser: Caleigh now owns this. Action item: Caleigh Barth to write up a blurb for refundables at the depot fundraiser for Noah Burdett to add to "The Weekly."
- Motion to approve the budget put forward by Caleigh Barth. Seconded by Karen Andrews. The motion carried with all in favour by show of hands.

## **New Business**

- Movie nights: Tom Cutler says that Alex is willing to run movie nights again but needs people to pop popcorn during the day. One event per month is best for the school. November is available. Could be the night before parent teacher interviews at the same time as the PAC meeting on November 20. Action item: Tom Cutler to follow up on planning movie night for November 20 with Alex.
- 2. Quality foods money: PAC has money at Quality foods sitting there. Could use this money for concession to make some money for the PAC. **Action item: Renee van Doorninck to follow up on this.**
- 3. Fundraising ideas: Can we have a concession stand for the cross country event? Yes. Event is from 3:30pm to 4:30pm. Freezies that are still in storage. Action item: Emily to ask for volunteers for this event. School will have a float for us. District track meet has changed to be an inclusive track meet. Action item: Noah will ask if there are opportunities for fundraising at a jamboree.
- 4. Halloween Dance: Garth to DJ. Katie McGreevy to lead this.
- 5. Puntledge Apparel: Renee and Sara to work on this earlier this year. We wiill slightly increase cost as it was run without profit but the budget is at a deficit. **Action item:**Renee van Doorninck and Sara Flinn to start the process with the supplier.

**Trustees Report:** Shannon Aldinger - quick hello at the end of the meeting as the meeting went long.
