WHY A TOY LIBRARY?

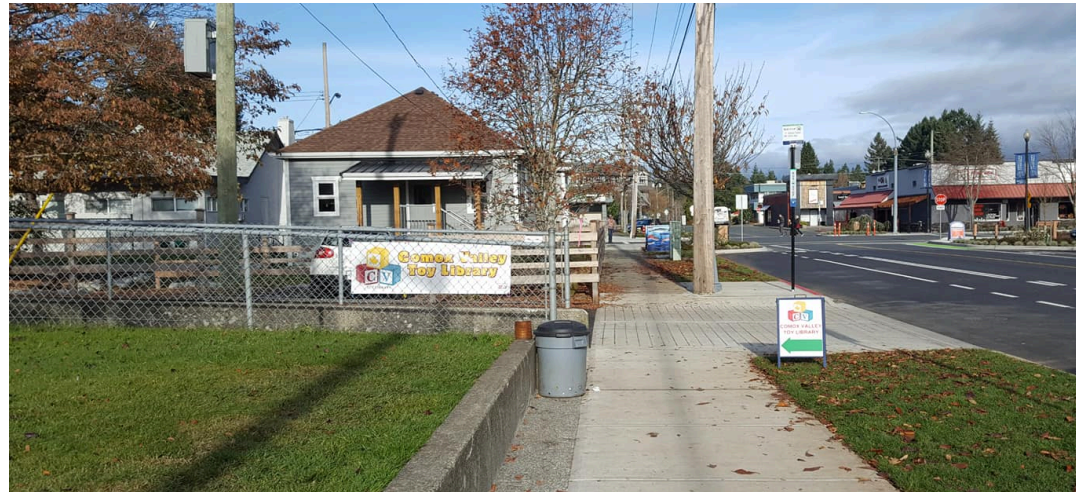
Children grow and change quickly, and they love novelty. Each new experience has new lessons and possibilities to offer. This means children get excited about new toys, play with them for while, then lose interest.
