


She is in a different classroom down the hallway for now. She will stay there until it is safe to come back to our room.

And when someone is causing trouble, to want to keep away from that person. Let's talk about some things that will help you stay safe...

> Constable Carlos told us some really **IMPORTANT** things to do during lock-downs.

When you hear Lock-Down during class time you need to... Stop what you are doing. Listen to your teacher. Follow your teacher's instructions. Be quiet. NO TALKING unless it is REALLY important. Keep away from windows and doors.

If you are at the bathroom or in the hallway when Lock-Pown is called... Go to the CLOSEST classroom - the classroom next to where you are.

Once you are in a room and the door is locked ... DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR or any window, not even if someone is knocking on it. Not even if the recess bell rings - stay with your teacher - that's the rule!
