Today in art class Ms. Grace is teaching us how to make more colors by mixing the ones we have.

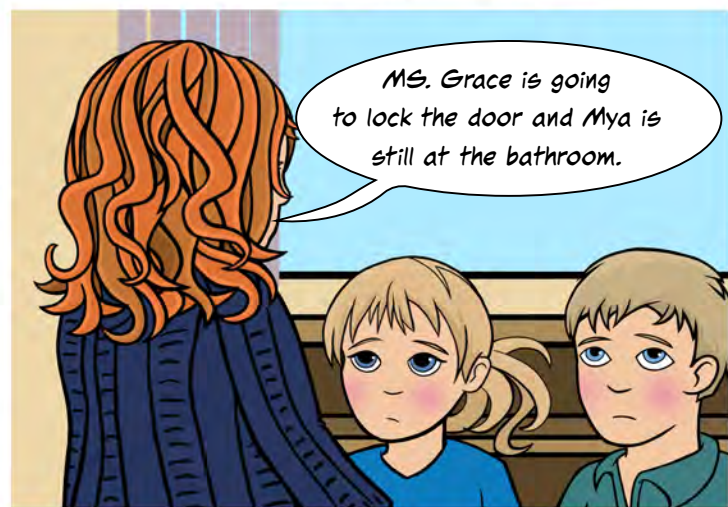
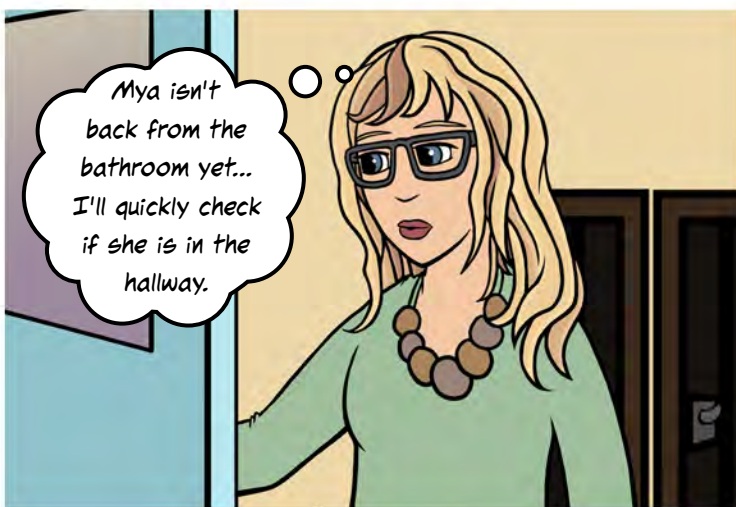
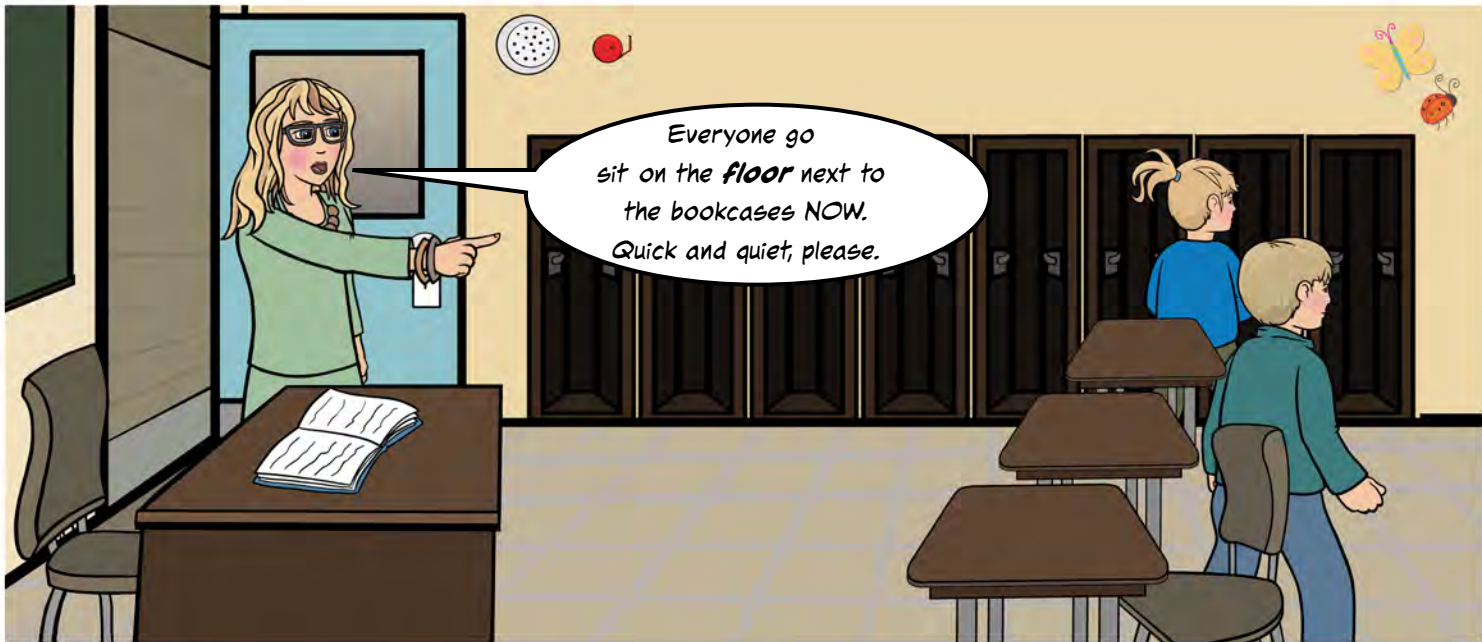


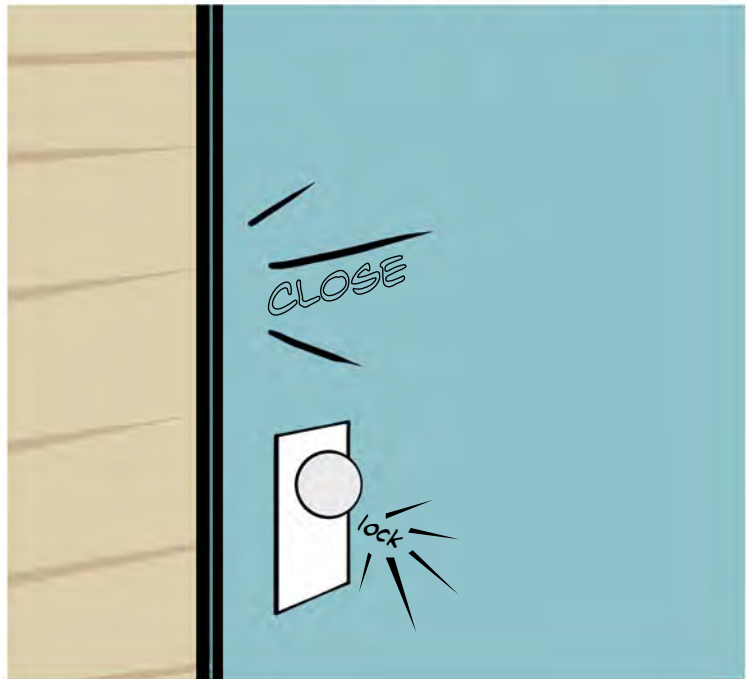
**LOCK-DOWN!!!**



Oh no, that means it is serious.









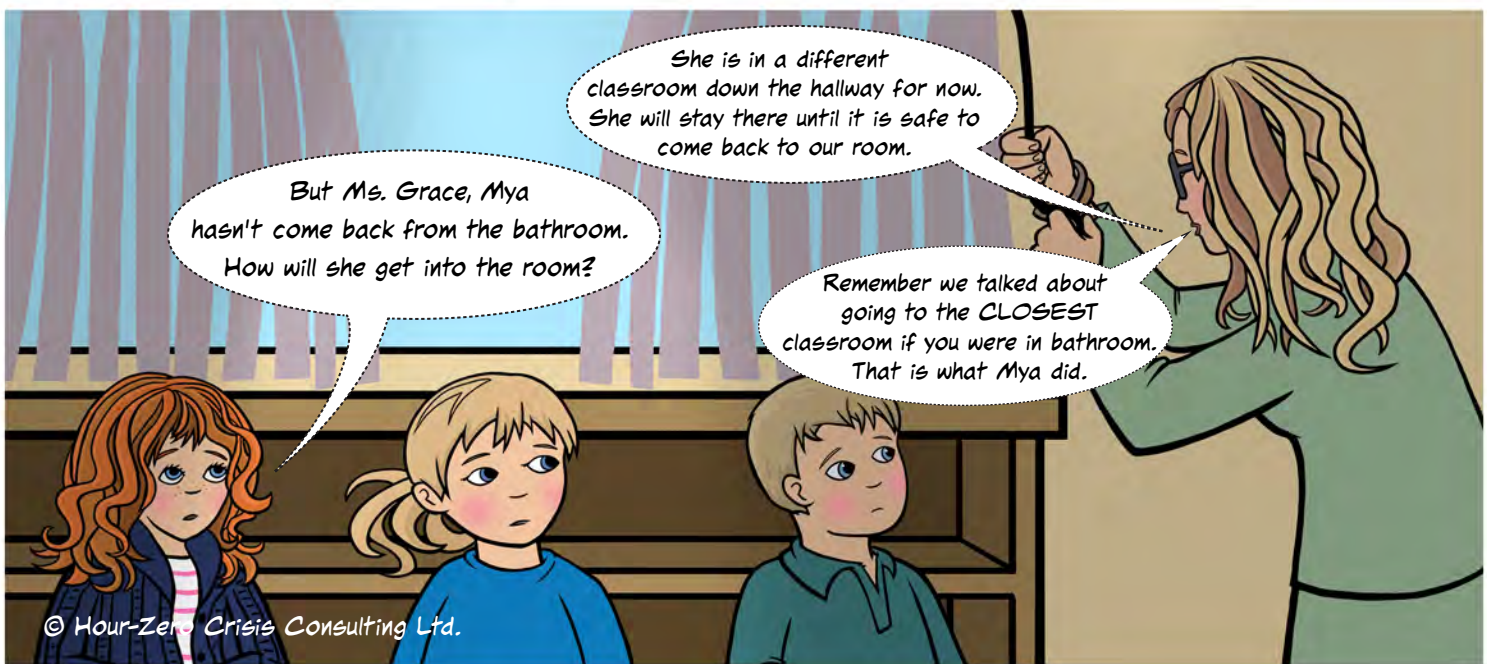
Good, Mya is safe in that classroom.

**When you hear Lock-Down during class time you need to...**

**✋ Stop what you are doing.**

**👂 Listen to your teacher.**

**➡ Follow your teacher's instructions.**

**Be quiet. NO TALKING unless it is REALLY important.**

**Keep away from windows and doors.**

**If you are at the bathroom or in the hallway when Lock-Down is called...**

**Go to the CLOSEST classroom - the classroom next to where you are.**

**Once you are in a room and the door is locked ...**

**DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR or any window, not even if someone is knocking on it.**

**Not even if the recess bell rings - stay with your teacher - that's the rule!**
