**7. School Office Summer Schedule** - The school office will be open regular school hours until Friday, June 27<sup>h</sup>. From Monday, June 30th until Thursday, July 3rd, the office will be open from 8:30 am to 2:30 pm. The office will then be closed for the summer and will re-open on Monday, August 25th.

**8. Summer and September Start-up Info** - You can expect an email from me on August 26<sup>th</sup> with specific start-up information (grades 1-7). Please email me at <u>stephane.leblanc@sd71.bc.ca</u> if you have to communicate with the school for any reason during the summer (between July 4th and August 25th).

<u>9. Year-End Reports</u> – Year-end reports will be given out to students on the final full day of school, Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. For students finishing the school year earlier, please let your teacher know of your last school day. Please know that year-end reports may not be ready before June 25th.

<u>10. School Supplies</u> – We will continue with the system of purchasing all necessary school supplies for students K-7 and families will be asked to pay their portion in September. The provincial government and SD71 have subsidized school supplies through a student affordability grant. They are providing 8\$ per student, which means parents will be asked to pay the remaining 32\$.

Payment for school supplies can wait until late August/early September, but if you must do it now, you can e-transfer \$32 to <u>robbroad@sd71.bc.ca</u>. Please be sure to write School Supplies 25-26 and your child's name. As always, parents are still expected to provide a backpack, lunch kit and water bottle. Families requiring financial assistance to pay for school supplies may contact any staff member.
