- <u>3. Halloween</u>: As families prepare for Halloween, here are a few things to consider when sending your child to school with their costume:
- \* We'll have a costume parade starting at 9:00 am Friday, October 31st
- \* Keep accessories to a minimum to avoid the disappointment of lost / misplaced / damaged items

- \* If a mask is part of a costume, it can be worn during the costume parade. Because a mask limits vision, we'll ask students to remove costume masks in the classroom and during recess (for safety)
- \* Guns, knives, swords and all such accessories are great for trick-or-treating at night....but not for school. Please keep them home.
- \* Candy is a fun part of Halloween. Everyone loves it, but please send sparingly following Halloween
- \* A change of clothing during the day is always helpful, especially with the expected rain Friday
- <u>4. Remembrance Day Assembly</u> As part of our upcoming Remembrance Day assembly, our school would like to honour the members of our community who have served or are currently serving in the military.

We invite families to share **photos** of family members who have served (past or present) along with the following information:

These photos and details will be included in a **presentation** during our Remembrance Day ceremony, helping our students see the real faces and connections that make remembrance personal and meaningful.
