2. Student Led Conferences – Your classroom teacher has sent a sign-up for next week's student led conferences on Thursday, April 16th. The conference is an informal learning update and will be structured in a way to ensure student agency and parent involvement. The teacher's role is to prepare students prior to the conference and to generally oversee the simultaneous conferences. These are not individual parent-teacher meetings.
