**2. Bike to School Week** - Students and staff are encouraged to ride or walk to school this week. **4. Parking around the school** – We continue to receive complaints from neighbours of parents blocking driveways around the school. Please be mindful of not parking in a way that blocks our neighbours from their driveways on Robb Avenue, Sable Crescent and other streets around the school. Thanks for your consideration

**5. Message from C.V. RCMP** - Comox Valley RCMP is reminding families that gas-powered dirt bikes and high-powered e-dirt bikes are not street legal and are not permitted on school grounds or for travel to and from school.

Schools across the Comox Valley have seen an increase in students riding these vehicles in unsafe ways near schools, neighbourhoods, roads and pathways. In some cases, students may not realize that e-dirt bikes are treated similarly to gas-powered dirt bikes under the BC Motor Vehicle Act and are subject to significant fines, vehicle impoundment and other penalties.

Comox Valley Schools is asking parents and caregivers to please ensure children are not riding dirt bikes or e-dirt bikes to school or on school property. These vehicles create serious safety concerns for riders, pedestrians, cyclists and other students.

We appreciate families working with us and local RCMP to help keep school communities safe for everyone.

**6. Field Trips and Outdoor Activities** : There are several class field trips in the next few weeks. Please check with your child's teacher if you are unsure about class trips and dates. Also, a hat and sun protection are always a good idea to pack in your child's backpack as there will be lots of outside time in the month ahead.
