6. Year-End Reports – Year-end reports will be given out to students on the final full day of school, Wednesday, June 24th. For students finishing the school year earlier, please let your teacher know of your last school day. Please know that year-end reports may not be ready before June 24th.

7. Summer and September Start-up Info- You can expect an email from me on September 1st with specific start-up information (grades 1-7). Please email me at stephane.leblanc@sd71.bc.ca if you have to communicate with the school for any reason during the summer (between July 3rd and August 30th)

8. School Supplies – We will continue with the system of purchasing all necessary school supplies for students K-7 and families will be asked to pay their portion in September. Previous subsidies from government and/or school district are no longer available and the cost to families will be \$40 per student.

Payment for school supplies can wait until early September, but if you must do it now, you can e-transfer \$40 to robbroad@sd71.bc.ca. Please be sure to write School Supplies 26-27 and your child's name. As always, parents are still expected to provide a backpack, lunch kit and water bottle. Families requiring financial assistance to pay for school supplies may contact any staff member.
