

GRADE 12 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Required Courses

- **ONE** of English Studies 12 or First Peoples Literary Studies or English Studies 12 Communication Skills ****All Grade 12 students are required to write the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment**
- **THREE** other courses at the Grade 12 level (4 credits each)
- **CAPSTONE:** Career Life Connections
- Electives

Credits – all required courses are worth 4 credits. Most electives are worth 4 credits.

Special Programs: ACE-IT (apprenticeships), Dual Credit (Canadian Politics / Law and Politics / Intro to Criminal Justice / Essay Writing / Critical Analysis Creative Processes), Work Experience 12, Transportation Trades, Construction Trades

NEW COURSES

Sports Leadership/PE (8 credits), Genocide Studies, Economics 12, Drafting and CAD Modelling, Yearbook, Contemporary Vocal Music, Girls Rugby, Modern Warfare History, Aspire to Action

FULL COURSE LOADS ARE REQUIRED!

Study blocks are for students who have a heavy academic load AND outside commitments (jobs/sports). In September, students must complete a Study Block Request form. Once it's completed, it is to be submitted to the Counselling Office. Principal approval is required.
