Application Deadline - March 11th, 2022 at 1:00 pm

Basic Information:

Purpose: "....to recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to the students pursuing post-secondary education."

There are only 5,500 awards distributed across BC school districts and independent school authorities.

Selected students receive a \$1,250.00 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Must also be a BC Resident.
- 2. Student must be enrolled at Georges P. Vanier Secondary School this current school year.
- 3. Student must be in a position to fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of current graduation year.

<u>Categories</u>: (Students may apply for any category but can receive only ONE scholarship). Please note that Involvement in these categories can take place in school and/or in the community.
