- 5. Grad Requirement Check with school counsellor
- 6. Library Fees

At Risk of Non-Grad letters have been made and will be sent home in the coming days if you are currently at risk of not meeting BC graduation requirements.



## **Careers and Capstone**

These courses are still a requirement for graduation. ### Post-Secondary Institution (PSI) Transcript Sharing

Grade 12 and adult students can view and order their transcripts to be sent to PSI's, prospective employers and themselves on the Student Transcripts Service at: www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca/



Students must create a Basic BCeID account to access their information. Students need only complete their PSI selections once in the current school year. Students should make their PSI selections by **May 1, 2022** but if needed, may add to their selections at any time through **July 10, 2022**.
