* **HORATIO ALGER SCHOLARSHIPS**

We are excited to announce that the 2022 Horatio Alger Association of Canada Vocational & Technical Scholarship application is now open! Scholarships are awarded to students who have faced and overcome great obstacles in their lives who wish to pursue a vocational or technical education at an accredited non-profit post-secondary institution in Canada. Each year up to **25 students** are awarded with scholarships **up to \$3,000** to help fund their education.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Horatio Alger Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship Program, an applicant must:

- Have completed high school (or earned high school equivalency credential) by Spring
- Be enrolled in a 3 year or less career or technical degree/certificate program in Fall that will lead to employment
- Demonstrated critical financial need
- Demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be under the age of 30
- Be a Canadian citizen
- **Priority Deadline: June 15, 2022**
Applications will be accepted until all scholarships have been awarded.
