Highlights of this month include -

#### New Classes at Grade 9

• The district supported Vanier's request for more blocks and create new grade 9 classes. We received a significant number of grade 9 registrations over the summer, with new families moving into catchment. With our enrolment confirmed in the first week, we were able to shift students into the new classes and hiring will be completed this week.

#### Athletics –
