Vanier Selected Bursaries- selected by Vanier Bursary Committee

1. Complete Bursary application (on website). (Fillable PDF or paper copy)
2. Check off Vanier Selected Bursary form at the top of the application form.
3. On the Bursary Check List (last page of application form), put a check in the box next to the title of the bursary/scholarship for which you want to be considered.

Donor Selected Bursaries- selected by donor groups

Steps:

1. Complete Bursary application. (Fillable PDF or paper copy)
2. Check off Donor Selected Bursary form at the top of the application form.
3. For **each** Donor Selected Bursary/Scholarship you are applying to, complete one of the application forms and **write/type the name of the donor selected bursary at the top.**
4. **Some** of the donor selected bursary/scholarships have an **additional application form** which will be noted in the description.

Online Donor Selected- Recipients are chosen by local donor organizations

- Each organization has its own unique application form, different requirements, and sometimes different deadlines.
- Submit your application directly to the donor either online or by email.
- Please take note of application deadline specific to each bursary.

District/Authority Scholarship Awards

- These awards, worth \$1,250 recognize graduating BC students in their chosen areas of interest or strength.
- Application is online under the Grad Bursary Tab or paper copy of application can be picked up in the counselling office.
- Students applying for this scholarship must demonstrate outstanding achievement in any of the following focus areas at school or in the community:
 - **Indigenous Languages and Culture**
 - **Fine Arts**
 - **Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies**
 - **Physical Activity**
 - **International Languages**
 - **Community Service**
 - **Technical and Trades Training**

GRAD ATTIRE PROGRAM

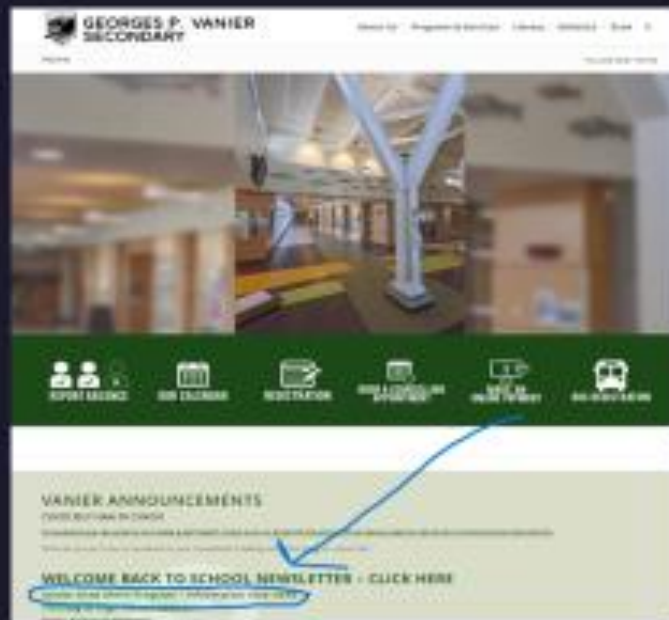
The Grad Attire program gives all students the opportunity to wear a lightly worn gown or suit on graduation day without the financial burden associated with purchasing a brand-new outfit
