BURSARIES / SCHOLARSHIPS

 database. You will be matched to scholarships and bursaries that you are eligible to apply for once
 you create an account.

- * Students interested in applying for the <u>2026 BC Excellence scholarship</u> (\$5000 scholarships awarded to 55 students across BC) are encouraged to get organized well before applications are due in February 2026. Make a checklist of the following required information that you will need to submit through the online application form by February 2026.
 - Written statement
 - Resume (in mandatory online format)
 - Reference letters (2)
 - Check out the details from the <u>2025 application (PDF, 1.1MB)</u> Note that this is an example only; the 2026 version is subject to change
 - Look for the online application to open in late fall 2025
 - Plan to meet all eligibility requirements

- * The Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship is awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment to and aptitude for a career in K–12 teaching. Students selected for this award receive a \$5,000 scholarship voucher from the Ministry of Education and Child Care that they can use to be reimbursed for tuition paid after they are attending an approved teacher education program in the Faculty of Education at a B.C. post-secondary institution. To qualify, the program must lead to eligibility to apply for a B.C. teaching certificate and teach in the K–12 school system in this province. Online applications will open in late fall. - * The Loran Scholarship awards are now open for applications! These awards offer a four-year leadership-enrichment program, financial support for undergrad, diverse opportunities for experiential learning, and a long-term supportive community of peers and mentors—people who will inspire and motivate you in your pursuit to make a difference.
