Application Deadline – Friday, February 27th, 2026 at 3:15 pm

Basic Information:

Purpose: “...to recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to the students pursuing post-secondary education.”

There are only 5,500 awards distributed across BC school districts and independent school authorities.

Selected students receive a \$1,250.00 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

Eligibility:

1. Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Must also be a BC Resident.
2. Student must be enrolled at Georges P. Vanier Secondary School this current school year.
3. Student must be in a position to fulfill the BC graduation requirements by August 31st of current graduation year.

Categories: (Students may apply for any category but can receive only ONE scholarship). Please note that involvement in these categories can take place in school and/or in the community.

Indigenous Languages & Culture

Fine Arts – Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music

Applied Design, Skills and Technology – Business Ed., Technology Ed., Home Ec., Computers

Physical Activity – not limited to PE courses

International Languages

Community Service – volunteer activity

Technical & Trades Training, Automotive, Robotics, Woodwork, Culinary Arts
(apprenticeship programs)
