Schulich Leadership Scholarship – 100 scholarships are awarded each year to students enrolling a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at 20 partner universities across Canada. Half are valued at \$120,000 for engineering scholarships and half are valued at \$100,000 for science and math scholarships. **School Sponsored Candidate (only 1 student can be nominated per high school).**

The BC Excellence Scholarship - is awarded to 55 BC high school graduates who have demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and who show aptitude for and commitment to their chosen career or area of post-secondary study. Successful recipients are awarded a \$5,000 scholarship voucher from the Ministry of Education and Child Care that they can use to be reimbursed for tuition paid after they are attending a post-secondary institution that is designated by the Province of B.C. (i.e., approved for Canada Student Loans) or a program provider that is approved by the Industry Training Authority. **School Sponsored Candidates (only 1 student can be nominated per high school).**

Cmolik Foundation Scholarship - The Cmolik Foundation Scholarship is a generous financial aid program designed to support students in British Columbia who have overcome adversity and demonstrate resilience, determination, and financial need. You can learn more or apply through the Cmolik Foundation website www.thecmolikfoundation.com/undergraduate. **School Sponsored Candidate (only 1 student can be nominated per high school).**

Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship - The Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship is awarded to 20 outstanding BC high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment to and aptitude for a career in K–12 teaching. Students selected for this award receive a \$5,000 scholarship voucher from the Ministry of Education and Child Care that they can use to be reimbursed for tuition paid after they are attending an approved teacher education program in the Faculty of Education at a B.C. post-secondary institution. To qualify, the program must lead to eligibility to apply for a B.C. teaching certificate and teach in the K–12 school system in this province. Students have seven years to redeem their Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship vouchers; an expiry date is printed on each voucher and extensions are not possible. *Please note that students may apply for both the BC Excellence and the Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarships but they will only be chosen as the recipient of one. **School Sponsored Candidate (only 1 student can be nominated per high school).**
