

GRADE 11 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Required Grade 11 Courses for ALL students:

- An English Language Arts 11
- A Science 11 or 12 (Strongly advisable to take a Science 11 before the Science 12)
- Social Studies 11 or 12
- A Mathematics 11 or 12 (Strongly advisable to take a Math 11 before the Math 12)
- Career Education 11 (Completed Online)

Note that in Grade 11, a large variety of course options are available. It is critical to spend time looking into prospective post high-school career or school plans in order to select the courses that will open up those pathways.

Special Programs: Train in Trades (apprenticeships), NIC Dual Credit (Begin post-secondary programs and courses while still in high school), Work Experience 12, Transportation Trades, Construction Trades, Metal Mechanical Trades

Explore Program: Hosted at Vanier in Semester 2. Students receive credit for PHE11, Pre Cal 11, Life Science 11, Outdoor Education 11 and EFP Lit 11. **Deadline to apply is March 13** – pick up form in the office

New Courses:

Senior Open Studio & Portfolio Development, Analog Game Design: Board and Card Games, Cosplay Props, Armour & Jewelry, Tabletop Game Terrain & Model Building, Entrepreneurship, Marketing & Management, CNC Machining & Design for Woodworking, LINK 11, Digital Media Arts, Language Explorations, Computer Science, Environmental Science, Political Studies, Explorations in Social Studies 11.
