

GRADE 12 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Required Grade 12 Courses:

- English Studies 12 **or** First Peoples Literary Studies 12
 - ****All Grade 12 students are required to write the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment**
- **THREE** other courses at the Grade 12 level (4 credits each) - Minimum
- **CAPSTONE**
- Career Life Connections (Completed Online)
- Electives

Credits: all required courses are worth 4 credits. Most electives are worth 4 credits.

Special Programs: Youth Train in Trades (apprenticeships), NIC Dual Credit (Begin post-secondary programs and courses while still in high school), Work Experience 12, Transportation Trades, Construction Trades

New Courses:

Senior Open Studio & Portfolio Development, Analog Game Design: Board and Card Games, Cosplay Props, Armour & Jewelry, Tabletop Game Terrain & Model Building, Entrepreneurship, Marketing & Management, CNC Machining & Design for Woodworking, LINK 11, Digital Media Arts, Language Explorations, Computer Science, Environmental Science, Political Studies, Explorations in Social Studies 11.

FULL COURSE SCHEDULES ARE REQUIRED – 8 COURSES!

Study Blocks: are for students who have a heavy academic load AND outside commitments (jobs/sports). Students must complete a Study Block Request form. Once it is completed, it is to be submitted to the Counselling Office. Principal approval is required.

Early Graduation: Students who intend to graduate early (end of semester 1), should indicate this on their online course selection. They are still required to select full course loads but will be contacted by a member of counselling or administrative staff to discuss their schedule and plans.

80 CREDITS (minimum) REQUIRED for Graduation!
