# Treasurer Report (Spring)

- As of September 26, 2022:
  - \$1659.18 in the General account
  - \$8124.80 in the Gaming account
  - \$2006.70 in the Grad Account (2020)
- Cheques issued (from 2021/22 budget):
  - \$15773.88 to Highland Gaming (Athletics, arts, clubs, etc)
  - \$124.96 + \$122.38 + \$51.50 Non-gaming Staff Appreciation Function
- Our PAC will be purchasing a BCCPAC membership at a cost of \$75.00
- We received a budget request from Megan Hedican in the amount of \$2000 to support the outdoor education students' trip to Quay Lake.

## Staffing/Enrollment:

- 2. Flex Block Occurs every Friday afternoon with teacher/staff available to support as needed, students are encouraged to attend

## **Extra-Sessional Classes:**

1. Jazz Band, Choir, Robotics, Improv/Drama – All programs currently in session

## **Extra-Curriculars**

- 1. Clubs Many clubs (yearbook, mental health, gardening, etc) are up and running
- 2. Teams Volleyball, cross-country, boys' soccer, aquatics teams in progress
- **3. Germany Exchange** An exchange trip to Germany will be on offer for the 2023/24 school year. Our school will host students from an all-girls school in UIm next fall; our students will travel to Germany during spring break 2024. A parent information meeting is upcoming to discuss costs, fundraising, etc.

# Trustee Report (Tonia)

- In August trustees attended the signing of the Learning Enhancement Agreement event at the K'omoks First Nations Band office. This agreement between SD71 and the K'omok's First Nations is aimed at improving Indigenous grad rates/ensuring successful transitions for school age students. This agreement will be in place for 5 years.
- Our district has received \$980,000 from the provincial government via the Student & Family Affordability Fund, discussions are underway to determinate the best way to allocate these funds
- Municipal elections (including school trustees) upcoming on October 15
- Newly elected trustees will commence strategic planning in January 2023

# Old Business

- Grad Funds (2020)
  - Funds raised for our 2020 grads have not been utilized to date. Attempts to find volunteers willing to organize an event to celebrate the students of this grad year have been unsuccessful. At our next meeting we will explore alternative options for spending these funds (eg. bursary, charitable donation, re-allocation to PAC, bike racks)
