## Assessment Strategy for Students in

## Grades 10-12

## Practice Records

- Practice is worth $\mathbf{2 0 \%}$ of each term mark.
- Recommended practice times:
- Grades 10-12 = 30 minutes per week
- Extra practice can earn up to $\mathbf{5 \%}$ bonus each term as well.

Playing Assessment

- Playing assessments are worth $\mathbf{4 0 \%}$ of the term mark.
- Band students will be tested individually each term by playing in front of a teacher.


## Ensemble Skills

- Are worth $\mathbf{4 0 \%}$ of the term mark.
- Based on class participation and effort - student who makes a sincere effort to listen, learn and improve should do well.
- Students who are involved in musical activities outside of school time can apply for a 5\% enrichment credit.
- Students who show up without music or instruments cannot participate to the best of their abilities in a performance-based course. As there are only $\underline{21}$ classes in each term, students who forget their required materials more than once a term will lose 5\% of that term's participation mark.
- As in-class performance is a major part of all music classes, regular attendance is crucial. Extended absence from music classes will affect not only the student's progress, but also their grade.
