- **Positive Eco News:** The Seine River, once an ecological disaster zone in the heart of Paris, has transformed from a nearly lifeless waterway to a thriving ecosystem over the past five decades. In the 1970s, the 482-mile river supported only three fish species. Today, nearly 40 different fish species and diverse marine life swim in its waters, including jellyfish, crustaceans, and shrimp. The comeback stems from advanced water purification treatment, waste management improvements and decades of systematic efforts to clean and protect the river.
