Required Courses

- First Peoples Literary Studies/Writing 11 or First Peoples Writing & New Media 11
- Career Life Education 11 (completed online)
- Socials 12
- A Science 11
- A Math 11 (Workplace **or** Foundations **or** Precalculus) Explain the pathways
- Electives – choose 4, plus 2 alternates
- Counsellor notes – any special requests (already completed a course online, failed a required course etc.
- Study blocks only available to grade 12 students
