

GRADE 12 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Required Courses

- **ONE** of English Studies 12 or First Peoples Literary Studies or English Studies 12 New Media
All Grade 12 students are required to write the Gr. 12 Literacy Assessment
- **THREE** other courses at the Grade 12 level (4 credits each)
- **CAPSTONE**
- Career Life Connections 12 (completed online)
- Electives – choose 7
- Counsellor notes – any special requests (already completed a course online, failed a required course etc.

NEW ELECTIVE COURSES - Film Studies, Media Design/Film Studies, Photography/Creative Writing

80 CREDITS (minimum) REQUIRED for Graduation! (64 by end of grade 11)

External credits – bring in certificates to counsellor - athletics at the provincial level, music (royal conservatory), cadets, driver training etc.

FULL COURSE LOADS ARE REQUIRED – 8 COURSES! Even if planning on early grad/special program

Study blocks are for students who have a heavy academic load AND outside commitments (jobs/sports). Principal/Vice Principal approval is required.
