Rationale

1-3 reasons for choosing goal

- Arts education, though offered regularly, could be offered more deeply. We noticed in our year where we created a play as a school community that it was a vehicle for social emotional learning (sel) and learner confidence grew.
- Regular "music times" with certified instructors were identified by parents as an area they would like to see brought back into our school
- Attention to visual arts elements and principles of design was highlighted as an area for curricular improvement by the school community
- We have been focusing on social emotional learning and executive functioning skills and the arts could be an avenue to continue this pathway
