Assessment & Reporting

This year, reporting will look a little different than in the past. The Ministry of Education's Student Reporting Policy for K-9 students requires parents/caregivers be provided with at least 4 Learning Updates during the school year. Please be aware that the Ministry reporting guidelines are currently under revision and may change again for the 2023-24 school year. This year, at the Hornby School, reporting is as follows:

Term One: October - Interim Progress Report
November - Parent-Teacher Conferences

Term Two: March - Student-Led Conference
- Written Interim Report

Term Three: June - Showcase of Learning
- Student Self-Assessment
- Summary of Learning

Please be reminded that teachers are always available to meet with parents/caregivers to discuss student progress and address any concerns. Feel free to contact them for an appointment, at any time.

Students establish goals, receive ongoing feedback from their teachers through formative assessment, and have opportunities for peer and self-assessment during the school year.

Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten Registration will be happening in January. There will be more information to come early in the new year.

- **If School District #71 is closed due to weather conditions, HORNBY SCHOOL WILL ALSO BE CLOSED. THE PHONE TREE CALLOUT WILL NO LONGER TAKE PLACE.**
- If ONLY the Hornby school is closed (this would be highly unusual), we will e-mail families but NO LONGER MAKE EMERGENCY PHONE TREE CALL-OUTS.
- If the power goes out during the day, we will continue regular operations, unless there is a decision to close for safety reasons or if there is an issue with our generator. If the decision to close the school is made once school is already in session, we will telephone parents/guardians/emergency contacts.
- It is **VERY** important we have your verification forms with alternate emergency contacts.
