TMcPhail	Comox EI? - State of disrepair, upgrades earthquake wise, continue to look at it, possible partnership with Comox
	Hiring? Priority to hire Indigenous teachers? - Not many apply with the Indigenous ancestry
	Provided priority may make a difference - CDTA – topic has been discussed, looking at indigenous experience equal to academic experience, institutional barriers
SLeslie	Wonders— Section 42 - Indigenous applicants where do they fit? District stand on Truth and Reconciliation, Indigenous applicants need to rise to the top, make sure they get an interview, have them on stand by when jobs come up you know who you have. This action is the equity for all educators
BCarlos	Section 42 is the human rights exemption, successful with the InEd department, coordinator is recruitment, 1 position vacant now and we are on the verge of having a full indigenous team, teachers, administrator, and K/1 Program teacher is requirement Any queries I receive, I encourage to apply via make a future
SLeslie	District as a whole, is there a structure in place for hiring Indigenous teachers?
KShopland	NIC has a human rights, UVIC has a new position considered under section 42, fully looked at first
LPokiak	NWT Gov't hiring policy states that if you have Indigenous ancestry, and are qualified for the posted positions, you would be prioritized in the hiring process.
TMcPhail	University policy in place allow equity across all divisions

• Trustee/IEC Liaison SLeslie, CSacht

- Tuesday Heather Royal-Brant joined the open committee of the whole, 23-24 budget and budget process
- Explained about targeted funds received are for InEd students only
- Equity scan meeting next week, governing group is meeting, strategic planning, conversations, district data,
- Invitation sent out to come to lunch/dinner with the Trustees and Senior Management.
- Conservative with the budget, we are at the mercy of the province for funding
- SLeslie all about priority, lot of \$\$ are paid to staffing, teachers are big tickets to pay out
- SD71 asking for more \$\$, growth in the district needs more funding

TMcPhail	Process of budgets – are they different for each department?, is the IEC budget presented to the Trustees or ?
BCarlos	presents a proposed budget to the IEC, then works with the Director of Finance, will be presenting today to the IEC at the in-camera meeting
TDemeo	Approved by TDemeo, questions the budget but does not change the budget, numbers added up by Finance. many districts have no approval of the IEC

KShopland To confirm, the IEC's role is to approve the targeting funding budget, and that the budget approved by the IEC cannot be changed without discussion with IEC. **TDemeo** Yes, the IEC approves the targeting funding budget, which is later approved by the Board as part of the overall budget for the District. **BCarlos** IEC supports people in front of kids, less stuff more kids **KNeufer** Is the teacher staffing directly to support students with ancestry? **BCarlos** InEd teachers support all teachers, targeted funding - not permitted to hire enrolling teachers All teachers are under the 71 umbrella, seniority entitled to a job, **TDemeo KNeufer** Would the district support this InEd Curriculum support teacher position if not funded by InEd? Quite possibly **TDemeo LPokiak** What is the budget process for approving the InEd budget? **KShopland** IEC creates a budget committee to discuss the next years budget, IEC approves and then BCarlos presents to TDemeo Lpokiak Usual budget process does not give the opportunity for deeper conversations, not much time to discuss **BCarlos** IEC has approved 3 new positions, budget will be presented at the District Budget meeting and will ask SD71 to pay for these positions KShopland need to prioritise the budget on how the funds are being spent, allocate to new items, create an action item to consult with council, look at a budget item every meeting **BCarlos** upcoming capacity building days - might be a good time to review the budget
