- Superintendent JMorrow
 - Met with FChitty and CMcKay re: LEA, we are not where we would like to be
 - Following up on Nov 10th to create a collaborative plan
 - InEd staff and employees all do not have the same experience, there is an emotional heaviness to meet the needs of Indigenous students
 - School Board's Strategic Plan deadline extended until end of current school year
 - Creating parallel teams District and indigenous Education 2 separate entities lead learner, need someone at a senior level to manage the complexity of Indigenous Education
 - Replacing previous Assistant Superintendent / Director positions with four Associate
 Superintendent positions
 - The fourth Associate Superintendent position posting out in January will be for an Indigenous Associate Superintendent
 - Conversation with IEC in December about the posting re: qualities and qualifications of the InEd Associate Superintendent

TM – budgets – other roles paid for by core funding

JM – must go through the budget process, intention to have more support for those roles from core funding

TM – approval of targeted funding by IEC next school year?
