Messaging for week of Nov 6th

1. Good luck in your zones – many are completing this week – please register even if close to qualification and you wish to attend
2. Banquet – My plan for the TWU/UBC game has been thwarted. They switch the home and away, so UBC is hosting on the 25th and not TWU. UBC is much farther away than the LEC so this won't work. Thinking of alternative but it just may be an individual team dinner night. Sorry this did not work out.
3. **NEW** - player eligibility – despite this not being a BCSS sanctioned event this is also not an invitational tournament. We try and keep it as legitimate as possible with berthing allotment, rules, and rosters In an effort to legitimize the championship and in the spirit of fair play ... Players who take part in your Senior zone playoffs are considered Senior rostered players and therefore will be ineligible to play in this event. Your Stars roster should be dated later than Nov 22nd, 2022 to ensure this.

From BCSS - Students who move up will no longer be eligible to play on the lower age-group team in that season, and will be moved on the date specified.

4. **NEW** - Kootenays – they have completed their zones. I have only heard from one team, but they did qualify and don't intend to travel. Anyone in the Kootenays know the zone winner and/or second place? Please have them register.
