

# Ministry of Education District/Authority Scholarship Application Package

### Mark R. Isfeld Secondary School

#### **Basic Information:**

Purpose: "... to recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to the students pursuing post-secondary education."

There are only 5,500 awards distributed across BC school districts and independent school authorities.

Selected students receive a \$1,250 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

#### **Eligibility:**

- 1) Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Must also be a BC resident.
- 2) Student must be enrolled at Mark. R. Isfeld Secondary this current school year.
- 3) Student must be in a position to fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31<sup>st</sup> of current graduation year.
