On behalf of the athletic department at Mark R. Isfeld Secondary, thank you for participating on one or more of our athletic teams. It is our wish that you enjoy a challenging and rewarding season in your chosen sport(s).

As you may be aware, participation on a school team requires a commitment of time and energy as well as finances. Our school has made a solid contribution to support athletics in the form of TOC (Teacher-on-call) days for traveling coaches and additional funds for tournament entry fees. Furthermore, our PAC supports the purchase of <u>some</u> new uniforms each year. Despite this support, our athletic department is challenged to meet rising costs of uniforms, equipment and facility usage.

Therefore, students participating on athletics teams for the 2023/24 season are asked to pay an Athletics User Fee.
