The Environmental Protection Agency estimates that <u>14.5 million tons</u> of plastic packaging and containers are produced annually. Plastics are made from oil, so more plastic recovered for recycling means less dependency on oil. It is estimated that with our current increases in the production of plastic packaging, by 2050 plastics will make up approximately 20% of our oil consumption.

Drop off your plastic wrap, ziploc bags, chip bags, and soft plastic packaging to a bin in the front foyer to ensure it doesn't end up in the landfill!
