Grad tickets are available at the office! BEFORE you can pick up your tickets, you need to:

- have all school fees paid (check MyEd)
- have your 30 work/volunteer hours in (see Work Experience office)
- all course credits met (see VP if unsure)
- Go the Library first to get your Library clearance slip: outstanding books returned or paid for
- Bursary thank you cards done

A reminder to log in and make your Post Secondary Institution selections in the [Student Transcripts Service](#) (STS). You will need to do this for post secondary institutions to be able to access your Transcripts. [Most public BC and Alberta universities and colleges and the Ontario Universities' Application Centre \(OUAC\)](#) can retrieve ongoing transcript updates as soon as authorized by the student in STS.
